Over the last two decades, documentary photographer, Andrew Lichtenstein, has concentrated on long-term projects of social concern. He has worked on a wide variety of subjects focusing mostly on the United States. His images have appeared in: Time, Newsweek, U.S. News and World Report, Stern, Mother Jones, Atlantic Monthly, Life, Rolling Stone, the New York Times, and others. He has also helped produce a number of multimedia stories for MSNBC, NPR, and Slate.

In 2007, Charta published his first book, *Never Coming Home*. The book is a collection of photographs taken after attending military funerals for over sixty American soldiers who were killed in Iraq.
